I have set up a very simple, non-indexed website that serves as a database for the documents I use to reflect on the issues involved in opening up science and the means of doing so. I also post the various conferences, articles and interviews I give to promote the openness of scientific productions (peer-reviewed articles, codes and data) in order to improve exchanges between researchers and test the reproducibility of their results. My aim is, for us researchers, to better define our needs in order to change the current economic model for scientific publishing. Indeed, the replacement of the printing press by electronic publishing has enabled a few commercial companies to take global control of the publications we produce. They have managed to turn scientific publishing into a financially lucrative market for themselves (with profits of up to 40%), not only by privatizing the dissemination of publicly-funded research results, but also by controlling the evaluation of research and the careers of researchers.
